GROUP PREP

In preparation for group, <u>watch Emmanuel's Weekend Services message</u>, then answer the following discussion questions.

INTRODUCTION

♪ Money, money, money... money! ♪ We are constantly thinking about money, stressing over money, working for more money, spending money or finding ways to save money. But how often do we think about how we can give our money away? We fool ourselves if we don't think our relationship with money is uber-spiritual. To thrive, it is essential to allow God to guide our stewardship of money.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. By what standard should we decide what is or is not a generous lifestyle? Do you consider yourself generous? Why or why not?
- 2. Read <u>1 Timothy 6:17-18</u>. Giving is commanded because it doesn't come naturally to us. Studies show that only 1% of Christians who make over \$75k/year give back the tithe (10%) to God's church, and on average, Christians give 2.5% of their income. Below are four reasons that keep Christians from living a generous lifestyle partnered with four biblical truths about money.

We don't give because we are selfish, but God cares about people and wants us to do the same.

 Read <u>Matthew 19:21</u>. How have you been blessed or witnessed someone else being blessed by Emmanuel?

We don't give because we are mistaken about the purpose of money, but money's primary purpose is to be an instrument of blessing.

Read Matthew 6:24. How should we position our finances to worship God through them?

We don't give because we believe lies about what money can do for us, but money will not make us happy.

• Read Acts 20:35. What makes it easy to believe that happiness is produced by receiving? Why is it so important to trust the principle that "it is more blessed to give than to receive?"

We don't give because we are short-sighted, but Christ-followers should be living this life for the benefit of God's kingdom.

- Read <u>Matthew 6:19-21</u>. If someone reviewed our bank account, what should they see to know we are living for heaven?
- 3. Why are we commanded to live a lifestyle of generosity?

Of the four reasons we don't give, which most resonates with you? Is there a reason not mentioned that keeps you from being generous?

If you begin living a more generous lifestyle, what benefits do you foresee?

ACTION STEP

4. Read <u>Hebrews 10:24-25</u>. What steps will you take to live a more generous lifestyle, and how could this group more intentionally motivate one another to stay consistent?
