Seasons of Group

SEASON 1: THE SERVANT

Generally, a group should be in this season for 3 months.

- LEADER ESSENTIAL #1 STAY CONNECTED
 - Every week, coach your group members to prioritize their own personal spiritual disciplines, such as daily time with God, prayer, journaling, solitude, fasting, listening to podcasts, etc.
 - Use action steps to create the habit of "staying connected" to God
- LEADER ESSENTIAL #2 CULTIVATE RELATIONSHIPS
 - One social event, submit attendance, use a text thread or the GroupMe app consistently, etc. Use a Social Event Coordinator.
- LEADER ESSENTIAL #3 PROVIDE CARE
 - \circ Manage the overall care with a Care Coordinator.
 - What struggles/needs do the group members have and how are they being met?
- LEADER ESSENTIAL #4 SERVE TOGETHER
 - Use a Service Coordinator and manage one service project per semester.
 - Where are your group members currently serving on the Impact Team at Emmanuel?

Transitional Queue: You have been a great example of these four leader essentials.

SEASON 2: THE CRUISE DIRECTOR

Generally, a group should be in this season for 6 months.

- LEADER ESSENTIAL #5 DELEGATE RESPONSIBILITY
 - o Group Commitment Card
 - Consistently managing and coaching is the key to healthy delegation.
 - o Examples of delegated responsibilities could include
 - Hosting Rotation
 - Snack Rotation
 - Social Time Rotation
 - Care Coordinator
 - Service Coordinator
 - Social Event Coordinator
 - Prayer Time
 - Facebook group page
 - Facilitating Group Discussion

Transitional Queue: You have a group member(s) with social and spiritual warmth.

SEASON 3: THE VISIONARY

Generally, a group should be in this season for 3 months.

- <u>REPLACE YOURSELF</u>
 - Vision casting 101 provide a strong why.
 - <u>Matthew 28:18-20</u> Multiplying is fulfilling the Great Commission.
 - <u>Philippians 2:4</u> Multiplying is putting others needs before our own comfort. <u>Hebrews 10:24-25</u> – Multiplying allows others to experience the type of spiritual community you've experienced.
 - <u>Acts 2:42-47</u> Multiplying partners with God by "adding to the number."
 - <u>2 Timothy 2:2</u> Multiplying allows you to influence others indirectly.
